- **Annual Civil Rights Training:** Each year federal and state funders require programs provide Civil Rights Training to all program members (existing and new employees) from an approved training source. The Nebraska Crime Commission has created a PowerPoint which will take about 15 - 20 minutes to complete. (Remember to keep a training sign-in sheet of any employee who has completed
